

# Key Polling Results: Renewable Energy

Conducted between September 13 and 26, 2023

Released October 16, 2023

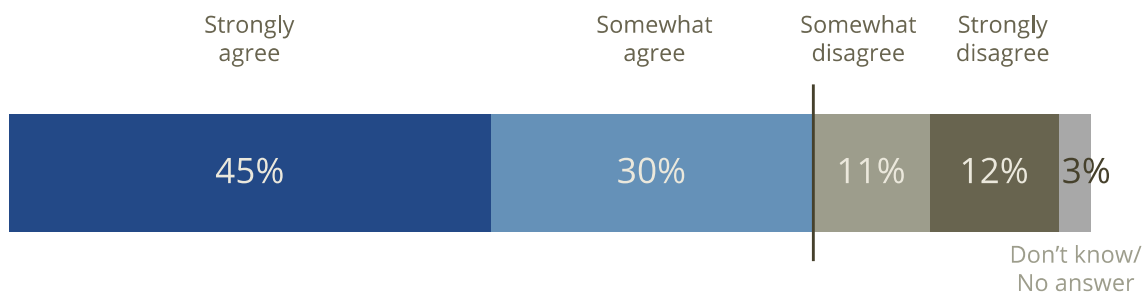
## Methodology

Survey questions were administered through the TrendWatch Alberta Omnibus Survey, under the direction of Janet Brown Opinion Research, between September 13 and 26, 2023.

TrendWatch Alberta is a monthly omnibus survey of 900 Albertans, ages 18 and over. The margin of error for a probability sample of 900 people is plus or minus 3.3 percentage points, 19 times out of 20 (i.e., at a 95% confidence interval).

Please indicate whether you strongly agree, somewhat agree, somewhat disagree, or strongly disagree with each of the following statements:

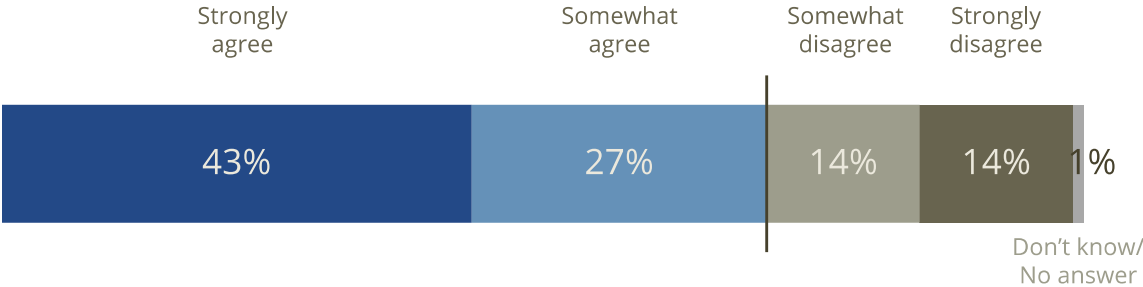
I would like to see more renewable energy projects developed in the community where I live.



- 45% Strongly agree
- 30% Somewhat agree
- 11% Somewhat disagree
- 12% Strongly disagree
- 3% Don't know / No answer

Overall, 75% agree while 23% disagree.

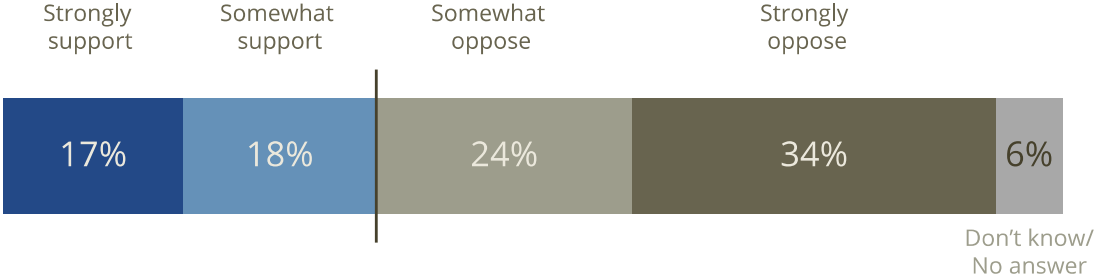
The Government of Alberta should be doing more to encourage future development of emissions-free energy, such as wind and solar power, in the province.



- 43% Strongly agree
- 27% Somewhat agree
- 14% Somewhat disagree
- 14% Strongly disagree
- 1% Don't know / No answer

Overall, 70% agree while 28% disagree.

The Government of Alberta recently made the decision to put a seven-month pause on the approval of new renewable energy projects over 1 megawatt. Do you strongly support, somewhat support, somewhat oppose, or strongly oppose the Government's decision to pause new renewable energy projects in the province?



- 17% Strongly support
- 18% Somewhat support
- 24% Somewhat oppose
- 34% Strongly oppose
- 6% Don't know / No answer

Overall, 35% support while 58% oppose.
